How exactly that will look and how long that season will last is only known to God, but we have the privilege of being part of it together as we all continue onward towards God's ultimate goal of restoring all creation, ushering in the new heavens and new Earth.

Many thanks to everyone for your support of our quilting ministry! After cushioning the pews with 80+ quilts on Quilt Weekend in September, we delivered 58 large quilts to Lutheran World Relief and 14 kid-size quilts to Ronald McDonald House at Central DuPage Hospital. Quilts that were purchased and donations that were collected added up to over \$1,100--providing funds to create many more quilts in the year ahead.

Our newest collection of quilts was put to use during worship on a Sunday morning in late October in our very chilly sanctuary. What a bonus to be able to test out their warming properties!!

This group has been rolling papers for over 70 years. The money they earn from selling the rolls to local florists and manufacturing plants help the school and church. Although the demand is still there for their rolls of paper, their supply has diminished as people no longer get printed newspapers. 
